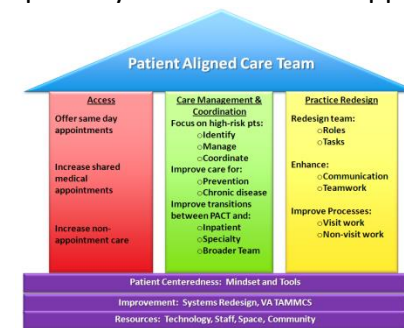
Target Audience
